FRAUD ALERT REMINDERS

If you receive a call, video call, text, email, or other form of message from someone unknown and something doesn't feel right, remember:

- Don't answer unfamiliar numbers
- **If you do answer, do not share personal or account information**
- Don't click on links
- Go to websites in a trusted way (websites can be faked)
- If they are claiming to represent FFCU, let them know **you will contact us directly.**
- **Call us to verify the situation**
- **Do not let them scare you!**

Remember to **Pause, Ask, and Protect.**

Pause: take a moment before acting, especially if it feels urgent.

Ask: talk it through with someone you trust or us.

Protect: your financial and personal information.

HELP STOP DEBIT CARD FRAUD

Over the past several years, instances of fraud using debit card information has been on the rise. While we take steps to avoid this type of fraud, FFCU has not been exempt. It takes all of us protecting our debit card information, staying informed, and adopting protective measures to safeguard our financial well-being. To the left here are some great tips to start! Also, don't forget that we have a few tools to help keep your card safe. One of which is our Card Suite Lite app, which is a tool that allows you to choose merchant types allowed to debit the card, set limits separate from your normal daily limit, and location matching, as well as freezing the card from the app. Just remember we are here to help you!
